# Baseline carbon assessment: Results (1/3)

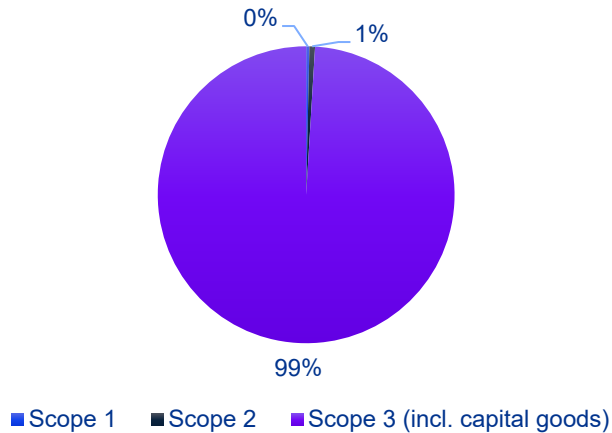

The results of the assessment are presented below.

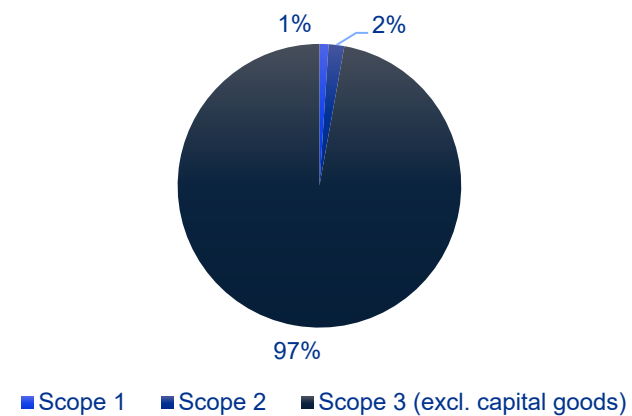

Total carbon emissions (incl. capital goods)



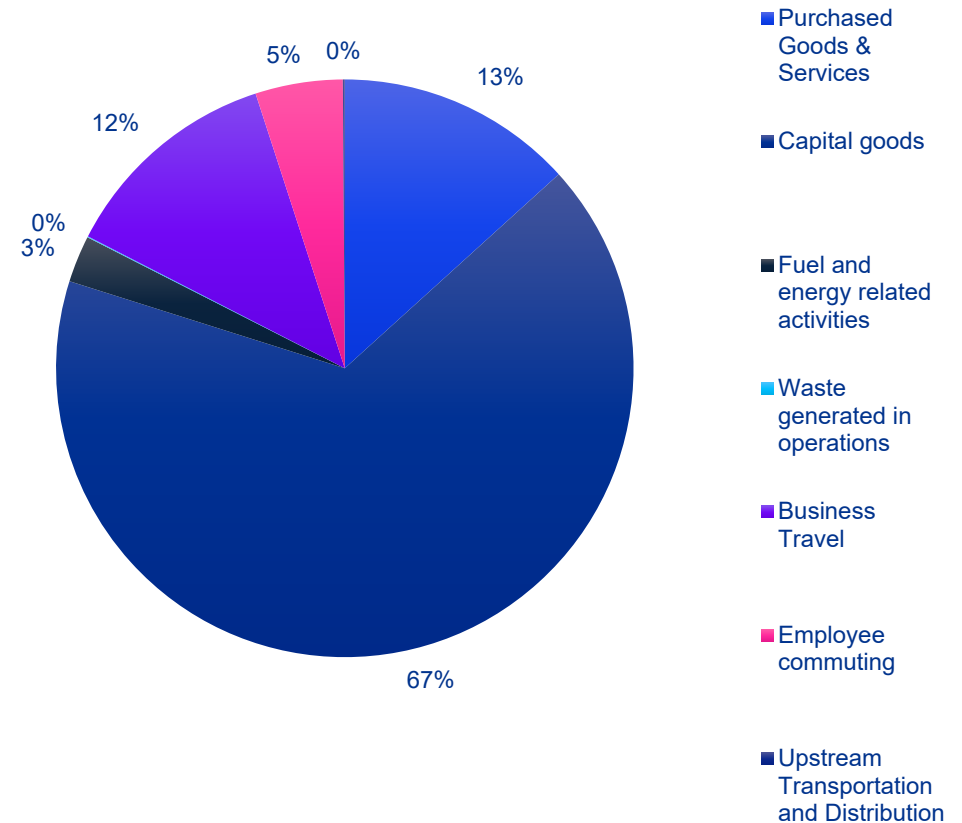
Total carbon emissions (excl. capital goods)
